## From the Principal's Desk

## **DRESS REHEARSALS**

We will be having a full dress rehearsal tomorrow at the hall and this will be our final play practice before the big performance on Thursday. It is very important that all children bring their costume tomorrow. This is the only opportunity we have to take photos of each act in full costume. These photos are later used in production publicity, if your child isn't in costume they can't be included. This means they can't be put on the website, displayed on education boards, included in school newsletters etc.

The second reason that bringing their costume tomorrow is so vital is that we have to see if they are practical. It's too late to make adjustments on Thursday, this has to be done tomorrow. The children also have to see everybody in costume tomorrow so they aren't distracted on Thursday. Sadly every year a number of students either forget their costume or aren't organised. I've been asking and checking for the last week and nobody has informed us that their costume isn't ready so let's hope no one forgets. Students can come in their costumes (black pants, appropriate tops) and change later or you can wash your costume ready for Thursday night if they remain in them. Whatever is easiest/safest for you. Specialist costumes eg. Clowns/Ringmasters etc should only be used in rehearsals for safety sake. Tomorrow can be a mufti day, costume day or combination. We will not be rehearsing Thursday so I expect every student to be in normal uniform. Any school based costumes/props are always left at the hall for safety sake. If you aren't sure what to do about costumes please ask but don't forget to organise your children for Wednesday and Thursday performances.

#### **EARLY HOME TIME - CONCERT DAY**

Don't forget the children can go home at 2.00pm or earlier providing you pick them up. The idea is to give the kids some time to relax. I will be walking to the crossing at 2.00pm to ensure all children cross safely. Remember going home early is optional, staff will still be here to supervise any students remaining at school; the option is yours.

## **TICKET SALES**

Remember these can be purchased at school before the night and eliminates waiting at the door. These pre bought tickets only let you in, hence avoiding waiting at the door BUT THEY DON'T GUARANTEE YOU A **SEAT INSIDE.** We don't have a numbering system so it is first in best choice of seats. There usually is enough seating for everybody but coming early is the best option. Hall doors will open at 6.30pm and I would like all students to be in the hall by 6.45pm. The show will start at 7.00pm or when the last of the necessary cast are in the hall with their appropriate costumes. It's a big show 90-120 minutes depending on entries/exits. We really won't know until tomorrow. Obviously, your children need a reasonable meal before- hand. I would avoid soft drinks, ice-creams etc. Students must wear their black pants or starting costumes. Please remember to turn off your mobiles, ensure small children are with you at all times and be a good audience, not just while your children are performing. We always encourage smaller siblings to be with family members but not during a production. The children have worked very hard on this production and deserve the chance to perform without sibling interference. I'm sorry but pre-schoolers can't join in. There are also some acts which are fast moving/throwing etc so we don't want any unnecessary accidents with younger siblings. If one of your younger children is not having a good day and making unnecessary noise, please do the right thing and take them outside. I know this is hard but we must consider all paying customers.

## **TOUCH FOOTBALL**

Yes it wasn't my choice but we are off to the Touch Carnival at Borambola the following day (Friday 2<sup>nd</sup>). This is a Year 2-6 event and all students have to be at school by 8.45am. Don't forget full sports uniform which includes the school hat and a drink bottle.
