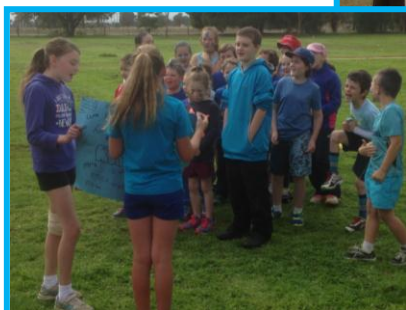
## UPS Athletics Carnival
