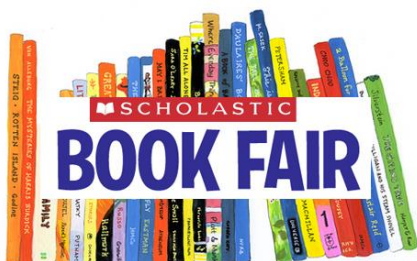
Book Parade
