Assembly

Please feel welcome to attend our first assembly for the year tomorrow at 3pm. We hold it fortnightly under the COLA. I would just ask that parents and visitors maintain a healthy social distance from each other.

Rain road

As we have had two very heavy downpours at pick up time last week, I would like to remind parents of the old habit of using the 'rain road'. How it works is that in the event of heavy rain, your child can wait at the toilet block under cover until you drive into the staff car park and stop beside the toilets. You will then continue forward and drive around the loop to exit out the same gate you entered, but if cars are lined up to enter you will need to turn left and drive around the block to exit the area. The tricky bit is the congestion of cars in this area. Please do not enter the staff carpark if the cars are banked up inside- if someone blocks the gateway nobody can exit! You will need to advise your child to wait at the toilets if you want to use this option. If the children are confused we will assume you are not using the rain road, so discuss it with them now so they understand. If you are happy with your child getting a bit wet, you can continue parking where you normally do and they can walk to you.

Kinder Rest Day

After their third week at school and a swimming carnival, some kinders may be ready for a rest by the end of the week. Other schools actually schedule in a Kinder rest day each week in February but it hasn't been the practice here. Please monitor your child's wellbeing and if needed, a day's leave is acceptable at this stage of their schooling.
