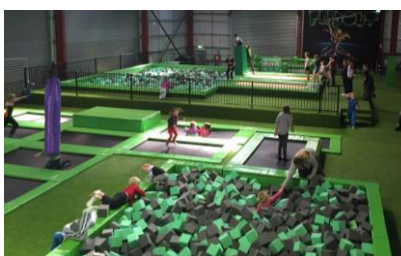
Infants Excursion
